

SCOTTISH RITE GRADUATE FELLOWSHIPS IN LANGUAGE DISORDERS

The Scottish Rite Graduate Fellowships in Language Disorders was established in December 2005. Two Scottish Rite Graduate Fellowships in Language Disorders, in the amount of \$10,000 each to be applied toward tuition, are awarded annually to graduate students in the Speech Language Pathology and/or Audiology programs whose career goals are to become specialists in childhood language disorders with a focus on children suffering from dyslexia or aphasia. The students must be interested in serving developmentally delayed children as well as those with a wide range of handicapping conditions and including parent/caregiver training.
